A BILL

To make standard time permanent, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Sunshine for Our Kids
5 Act of 2026”.

6 **SEC. 2. MAKING STANDARD TIME PERMANENT.**

7 (a) **REPEAL OF DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME.**—Section
8 3 of the Uniform Time Act of 1966 (15 U.S.C. 260a) is
9 hereby repealed.

1 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The first section of
2 the Act of March 19, 1918 (15 U.S.C. 261; commonly
3 known as the “Calder Act”) is amended by striking “Ex-
4 cept as provided in section 3(a) of the Uniform Time Act
5 of 1966 (15 U.S.C. 260a), the standard time” and insert-
6 ing “The standard time”.

7 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
8 this section shall take effect on the first Sunday of Novem-
9 ber that first occurs after the date of the enactment of
10 this Act.
